ORDER MODIFYING ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

Hearing procedures were established on January 19, 2012, by Order No. PSC-12-0031-PCO-TP, (Order Establishing Procedure). On January 27, 2012, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed a Motion to Modify the Procedural Schedule. AT&T Florida asserts that counsel for AT&T Florida will be out of the state and not available for the scheduled hearing date and respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer modify the procedural schedule in this docket. AT&T Florida states that it is authorized to represent that Express Phone Service Inc. (Express Phone) does not object to changing the date for the hearing.

Having considered AT&T's Motion and noting that there is no objection by Express Phone, I find it reasonable and to grant AT&T's motion. Therefore, I find it appropriate to modify the Procedural Order as set forth below.

Section IX of the Order Establishing Procedure shall be modified and the following due dates are hereby established to govern the key activities of this case:

Discovery Deadline	April 23, 2012
Hearing	April 30, 2012
Briefs	June 1, 2012

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Commissioner Eduardo E. Balbis, as Prehearing Officer, that Order No. PSC-12-0031-PCO-TP is modified as set forth in the body of this order. It is further,

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-12-0031-PCO-TP is reaffirmed in all other respects.



NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code; or (2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Office of Commission Clerk, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
