Dear Mr. Fowler:

Thank you for your e-mail on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, concerning the undisputed amount for RAM's Complaint No. 1009000W for March thru May, 2011 bills. As stated in your e-mail, using staff's analysis, the undisputed amount for March thru May 2011 bills is \$9,794.74. Based upon staff's analysis of data (see attachments), RAM has not paid the undisputed amount, \$9,794.74, in-full. Staff's analysis indicates that RAM still owes AUI \$2,793.42 (undisputed amount of \$9,794.74 less RAM's payments of \$7,001.32 = \$2,793.42). Pursuant to Rule 25-22.032(3), Florida Administrative Code, Protection from Disconnection, states "a company shall not discontinue service to a customer because of any unpaid disputed amount until the complaint is closed by Commission staff. However, the company may require the customer to pay that part of a bill which is not in dispute." Please make payment to AUI for \$2,793.42 by the close of business Monday, May 14, 2012, to avoid a possible disconnection of service.
