NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION  
ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

On April 6, 2012, Semnac Technologies, LLC, (Semnac) filed a petition for a Certificate of Authority to provide telecommunications services in the State of Florida, pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes. We are vested with jurisdiction on this matter pursuant to Sections 364.33, 364.335, and 364.336, Florida Statutes.

Upon review of the application, it appears/ that Semnac has sufficient technical, financial, and managerial capability to provide such services. Accordingly, we hereby grant Certificate of Authority No. 8828 to Semnac, which authorizes Semnac to provide telecommunications services in Florida.

Telecommunications services providers are required to comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-4 and 25-24, Florida Administrative Code, in the provision of telecommunications services in Florida.

In addition, pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, Certificate of Authority holders must pay a minimum annual Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) if the certificate was

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active during any portion of the calendar year. A RAF Return notice will be mailed each December to Semnac for payment by January 30th. Neither the cancellation of its certificate nor the failure to receive a RAF Return notice shall relieve Semnac from its obligation to pay its RAF.

If this Order becomes final and effective, it will serve as Semnac's certificate. Semnac shall retain this Order as proof of its certification.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Semnac Technologies, LLC, application for a Certificate of Authority is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED that Semnac Technologies, LLC, is awarded Certificate of Authority No. 8828, which authorizes Semnac Technologies, LLC, to provide telecommunications services throughout the State of Florida, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that this Order shall serve as Semnac Technologies, LLC's certificate and shall be retained by Semnac Technologies, LLC, as proof of certification. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth in the "Notice of Further Proceedings" attached hereto. It is further

ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this docket shall be closed.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing that is available under Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

The action proposed herein is preliminary in nature. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed by this order may file a petition for a formal proceeding, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code. This petition must be received by the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on July 18, 2012.

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.

Any objection or protest filed in this/these docket(s) before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.
