The Commission Staff requested that Florida City Gas (“FCG”) clarify the May 11, 2012, response FCG provided to Staff’s Data Request No. 8.

Accordingly, FCG provides the following clarification. FCG intends to apply the proposed rates (CSG and RSG) only to new generator-only customers after the effective date; therefore, there will be no immediate impact on current customers and no transfer of current customers to the new rates per the GS schedule’s September review cycle. This information replaces FCG’s May 11 response to Data Request No. 8.
