When gulf power applied for a rate increase, in conjunction with proposed future nuclear power plant, I wrote a letter strongly recommending consideration of a natural gas fired peaking plant instead of the nuclear plant. The Florida panhandle is NOT growing by leaps and bounds, and likely will not due to economic conditions that are likely to persist for perhaps decades (Japan has been in a "slump" since 1989). This link pretty well lays out the case against nuclear power relative to natural gas in areas of non-growth.
