
Docket No. 110260-WS – Application for staff-assisted rate case in Lee County by Useppa Island Utilities Co., Inc.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the Joint Motion requesting Commission approval of Settlement Agreement?

Recommendation: Yes. The Joint Motion requesting approval of the Settlement Agreement should be approved. The Utility should file a proposed customer notice and revised tariff sheets consistent with the Commission's decision within 15 days of the Commission vote. The approved rates should be effective for service rendered on or after the stamped approval date of the tariff pursuant to Rule 25-30.475(1), F.A.C., after staff has verified that the proposed customer notice is adequate and the notice has been provided to the customers. The Utility should provide proof that the customers have received notice within 10 days of the date of the notice.
