Verizon Florida LLC (Verizon) requests the Commission to certify that the federal high-cost funding provided to Verizon within Florida was used in the preceding calendar year and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended. Verizon requests that the certification be provided to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Universal Service Administrative Company by October 1, 2012.

Before this year, Commission certification was not required for carriers like Verizon that receive no federal high-cost funding other than Interstate Access Support (IAS). The FCC in its *USF/ICC Transformation Order*, ¹ however, revised 47 C.F.R. § 54.314 to require state certification before such carriers may receive IAS funding.

To facilitate certification, Verizon has enclosed the Affidavit of Jeanmarie Milla, which attests to Verizon's use of its federal high-cost funding in the preceding calendar year and the coming calendar year.


