

General rate increase application for its wastewater facility in Pasco County (SU 915) and water facility in Lee County (WU 920)

Dear Chairman:

Pursuant to Rule 25-30.430, Florida Administrative Code, please consider this correspondence a formal request for approval of a test year for Ni Florida, LLC ("Ni Florida"). Ni Florida intends to submit an application for general rate relief to the Florida Public Service Commission for its water and wastewater systems located in Florida. The company intends to submit the Minimum Filing Requirements ("MFRs") on or before October 15, 2012. The company's last rate proceeding for its wastewater facility in Pasco County, Florida was in Docket No. 090182-SU which culminated in Order No. PSC-10-0168-PAA-SU issued March 23, 2010. The company's last rate proceeding for the water system in Lee County was in Docket No. 100149 which culminated in Order No. PSC-11-0199-PAA-WU issued April 22, 2011.

Ni Florida requests an historic test year ending December 31, 2011. The requested test year is representative of a normal full year of operation.

The MFRs will include pro forma adjustments for purchased wastewater treatment expense due to increased wastewater flow due to recalibration, an erroneous billing multiple by Pasco county, processing fees for a new online bill payment option, increased bad debt expense, purchased water for a regulated system due to a price increase and expected fixed asset expenditures budgeted through December 31, 2012.

Pursuant to section 367.01(8), Florida Statutes, Ni Florida requests that the Commission process the petition for rate relief using the proposed agency action procedure.
