Consistent with Order No. 12-0062-PCO-EG, issued February 10, 2012, Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") hereby submits this Prehearing Statement:

c. FPUC's Statement of Basic Position

FPUC: The Commission should approve Florida Public Utilities Company's final net true-up for the period January through December 2011, the estimated true-up for the period January through December, 2012, and the projected conservation program expenses for the period January through December, 2013.

d. FPUC's Position on the Issues

GENERIC CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY ISSUES

ISSUE 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?

FPUC: An under-recovery of \$236,897.

ISSUE 2: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2013 through December 2013?

FPUC: FPUC seeks to recover \$1,066,236

ISSUE 3: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

FPUC: The Company asks for approval of a consolidated levelized conservation cost recovery factor for this period of \$.00155 per KWH.

ISSUE 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factor should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2013 through December 2013. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2013 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2013, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

e. Stipulated Issues

There are no stipulated issues at this time.

f. Pending Motions

FPUC has no pending motions at this time.

g. Pending Confidentiality Claims or Requests

FPUC has no pending requests for confidentiality at this time.

h. Objections to Witness Qualifications as an Expert

FPUC has no objections to any witnesses' qualifications at this time.

i. Compliance with Order No. 12-0062-PCO-EG

FPUC has complied with all requirements of the Order Establishing Procedure entered in this docket.
