

CUSTOMER NOTICE

OCTOBER 12, 2012

On February 17, 2012, Water Management Services, Inc. (the "Utility"), completed its application to the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for increased water rates, in which it requested a permanent revenue increase of approximately 55% for water service.

By Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-12-0435-PAA-WS ("PAA Order"), issued August 22, 2012, the Commission proposed a revenue increase of 38.76% for water service. These increases were designed to allow the Utility the opportunity to recover its reasonable and prudent costs for providing service, and a reasonable rate of return on its investment in facilities necessary to provide such water service. The Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") has protested the PAA Order, and pursuant to law the Utility may implement its requested rate increase during the pendency of the protest proceeding. However, the Utility has chosen only to implement the rates set forth in the PAA Order. The collection of the PAA rates and the increase in service availability charges will be held in escrow subject to refund should the ultimate increase be less than that in the PAA Order.

The increased rates and charges are effective for service on or after October 17, 2012.

The rates prior to filing and the PAA Order water rates are attached to this customer notice. The Commission also authorized an increase in service availability charges and the imposition of other service charges as set forth below.

This notice was prepared by the Utility and approved by the Commission Staff for distribution by the Utility to its customers.

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RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

The NSF Check charges that may be levied pursuant to Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, when a customer pays by check and that check is dishonored by the customer's banking institution. The Company will charge the amount set by Section 68.065 and Section 832.08(5), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. As currently set forth in Section 832.08(5), the following fees may be assessed:

- 1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50,
- 2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300,
- 3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- 4) or five percent (5%) of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.
