## Re: Docket No. 120244-EI - Petition for approval for base rate increase for Extended Power Uprate Systems placed in commercial service by Florida Power & Light Company

Dear Mr. Anderson:

By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Utility) provide additional information in regard to its petition.

FPL is proposing to increase the base energy charges only (as opposed to increasing both demand and energy charges) to recover the Extended Power Uprate Systems placed in commercial service. The Utility provided a response in a previous docket (Docket No. 100419-EI) that due to a relatively small increase a more simplified approach would be to change only one of the billing factors, the energy charge. FPL also cited Docket Nos. 080603-EI and 090421-EI where the Commission approved energy-only rate increases. In dockets where the Commission approved energy-only rate increases were \$1,297,979 in Docket No. 080603-EI, \$16,812,605 in Docket No. 090421-EI, \$2,199,261 in Docket No. 100419-EI, and \$20,856,111 in Docket No. 110270-EI. In the instant docket the requested revenue increase is \$246,053,294 and results in a \$2.59 increase to a typical 1,000 kWh monthly residential bill.

- 1. Please explain why the Utility believes the energy-only rate increase is appropriate in this instance when the requested revenue increase is significantly greater than those previously approved.
- 2. Please provide a side-by-side comparison of the calculation of a 1,000 kWh month, residential bill before and after the extended power uprate, showing each component separately.
