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PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: We're moving on, now we're moving on to Item Number 12.

MR. GARL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Good morning, Commissioners. I'm Steve Garl with Commission staff.

Item 12 is a request for approval of a special contract between Chesapeake Utilities Corporation and Suwannee American Cement, LLC, for transportation of natural gas to the Suwannee facility.

The proposed new contract would replace the now expired initial ten-year contract between the two parties. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the new special agreement.

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Commissioner Brown.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Garl. I pulled this because I just wanted to clarify a couple of things.

On page 4 of the recommendation, can you help me understand -- whereby Suwannee has paid \$2 million so far to Chesapeake over the life of the contract on an investment of 343,000, 343,000. To me it seems like they're paying more than what the investment is worth. Can you just clarify that?

MR. GARL: Yes, Commissioner. Chesapeake did 1 spend \$343,241 to connect gas service to the Suwannee 2 facility. Suwannee has paid, over the ten-year period, 3 over \$2 million, \$20,000 per month from service from 4 Chesapeake -- actually a total of \$2,409,000. 5 Chesapeake therefore does not believe that ratepayers 6 7 are at any risk, so the requirement for a letter of credit or surety bond was unnecessary because of their, 8 9 Suwannee's investment. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Ms. Jaber, do you want to 10 add anything to that? 11 MS. JABER: Thank you, Commissioner. 12 Lila Jaber with the Gunster law firm on behalf of the Florida 13 Division of Chesapeake. 14 15 I think the response is accurate. Obviously we agree with staff's recommendation. The number that 16 is quoted in staff's recommendation is a comprehensive 17 number that covers the cost of the initial 18 infrastructure as well as the service, so. 19 COMMISSIONER BROWN: With that, I would move 2.0 staff's recommendation, if there are no other 21 22 Commissioners. CHAIRMAN BRISE: It's been moved and seconded. 23 Any further questions or discussion? Seeing none, all 24 25 in favor, say aye.
