CUSTOMER SERVICE HEARING

Customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony at the beginning of the morning session on Wednesday January 16, 2013 (10:00 a.m.). Additionally, an evening session will be held beginning at 6:00 p.m., on Wednesday, January 16, 2013 for the purpose of hearing testimony from customers who were unable to attend the prior session. The customer testimony will be a part of the evidence presented in the formal hearing.
