AFFIDAVIT OF ANITA SHARMA

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Anita Sharma who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is Anita Sharma. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Manager, Demand Side Management Cost and Performance. My business address is 9250 West Flagler Street, Miami Florida, 33174. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed Revised Exhibit C and the documents that are included in Second Revised Exhibit A to FPL's Fourth Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of Information Provided Pursuant to Audit No. 04-070-4-1 for which I am identified as the affiant. Such documents or materials that I have reviewed and which, in whole or in part, are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information, contain or constitute competitively sensitive information, the disclosure of which could impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Specifically, some of the information pertains to negotiated terms with third party vendors for equipment and services related to FPL's implementation of demand side management and conservation programs. Some documents contain customer-specific account information, which if disclosed would impair FPL's competitive interests or those of its vendors. Moreover, it is FPL's corporate policy not to disclose customer-specific information. This policy includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh usage), conservation savings in kW, kWh and bills. FPL treats such information as confidential and does not disclose it, except as required by law to entities or persons other than the customer absent the customer's consent. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials.

3. Nothing has occurred since the issuance of Order No. PSC-11-0324-CFO-EG to render the information stale or public, such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate. Therefore, the information should remain confidential for a period of at least an additional eighteen (18) months. These materials should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business so that FPL can continue to maintain the confidentiality of these documents.

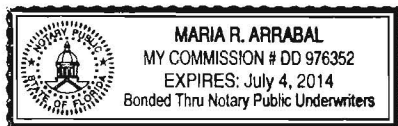

**AFFIDAVIT OF GERARD J. YUPP**


**BEFORE ME**, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Gerard J. Yupp who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is Gerard J. Yupp. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Senior Director of Wholesale Operations in the Energy Marketing and Trading Division. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed Revised Exhibit C, and the documents that are included in Second Revised Exhibit A to FPL's Fourth Request for Confidential Classification of Information Provided Pursuant to Audit No. 04-070-4-1 for which I am identified as the affiant. The documents or materials that I have reviewed and which are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information contain competitively sensitive data that, if disclosed, would place FPL at a competitive disadvantage. In addition, certain proprietary confidential information concerns billing statements for purchased power from several entities, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive interests of these suppliers. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials.
