In reviewing the WMSI hearing exhibits contained in DN 00529-13, it appears that one of the pages is not easily readable. OPC brought that to Staff's attention and Staff asked OPC to provide a legible copy of that page. (For reference, the unreadable page is enclosed and identified with the Bates stamp page (BSP) "110200 Hearing Exhibits – 00469". The page is located on or near PDF page no. 1656 of the online document. The header is not readable, but should read "Water Management Services, Inc. Late Filed Exhibit in response to Staff Interrogatory 86".) Per Staff's request, OPC is providing a replacement page as part of this letter.

The replacement page header is entitled, "Water Management Services, Inc. Late Filed Exhibit in response to Staff Interrogatory 86". OPC obtained the replacement page from Company's original filing with the Commission's website at: http://www.psc.state.fl.us/library/FILINGS/10/08775-10/08775-10.pdf. The replacement page in question is page 7 of the filing and is identified with the header, "Water Management Services, Inc. Late Filed Exhibit in response to Staff Interrogatory 86".

The page needing replacement is nearly unreadable because the page has been copied and scanned numerous times by WMSI, OPC, and Staff. OPC received a copy of the original as part of a seven page filing from 'WMSI on October 20, 2010 in the last rate case. OPC used its copy of page 7 in response to WMSI's discovery in this docket. OPC then copied, scanned, bates stamped page 7 as BSP "OPC00002.1", and provided it to WMSI as well as a courtesy copy to Staff. OPC was not aware that the quality of the copy provided had become degraded. Staff then copied, scanned, bates stamped page 7 as MBER-DATE NELLIES

BSP "110200 Hearing Exhibits – 00469" and made it part of Staff Exhibit 73. Unfortunately, in each successive step, the readability of page 7 diminished. OPC asserts that the page identified as BSP "OPC000021" in OPC's response to WMSI's discovery in this docket is a copy of page 7 from WMSI's filing in the last rate case which was subsequently identified as BSP "110200 – Hearing Exhibits – 00469". The enclosed copy of the original page 7 is the replacement page for the document identified as BSP "110200 Hearing Exhibits – 00469", in Hearing Exhibit 73 in DN 00529-13.

NOTE: Through 2002, the Utility experienced neither gains nor losses on sales transactions. The total gains shown above were incurred during the years 2003-2009. During that same period, according to the annual reports filed with the Commission at schedules F-4 & F-5, the utility's cumulative Net Operating Income was \$285,041 less than required, based on the actual expenses and actual cost of debt for those years. When the 2099 report is adjusted to reflect the normalization of expenses actually being incurred now, as presented in the MFR in this proceeding, the cumulative Net Operating Income is \$420,284 less than required, based on those actual expenses and actual cost of debt for those years. That is, the cumulative losses being experienced by the utility over this period are \$36,527 more than the gains on sales for the same period. This does not take into consideration that revenues in 2010, to date, are less than those in 2009 for the same period.
