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PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FUEL COST RECOVERY AND CAPACITY COST RECOVERY NET TRUE-UPS FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2012

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby petitions this Commission for approval of FPL's Net Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery ("FCR") true-up amount of \$4,550,654 under-recovery, and Net Capacity Cost Recovery ("CCR") true-up amount of \$7,913,484 underrecovery, both for the period ending December 2012. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

- 1. The \$4,550,654 net FCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2012 through December 2012 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule 1, page 2 of 2, attached to Order No. 10093, dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of FPL witness Terry J. Keith, which are being filed together with the Petition and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. By Order No. PSC-12-0664-FOF-EI, the Commission approved FCR Factors for the period commencing January 2, 2013. These factors reflected an actual/estimated true-up over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2012 through December 2012 of \$99,206,321, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-12-0664-FOF-EI. The actual overrecovery, including interest, for the period January 2012 through December 2012 is \$94,655,667. The \$94,655,667 actual over-recovery, less the actual/estimated over-recovery of \$99,206,321 BER-DATE

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which is currently reflected in charges for the period beginning January 2, 2013, results in a net FCR true-up under-recovery of \$4,550,654 that is to be included in the calculation of the FCR factors for the period beginning January 2014.

- 3. The \$7,913,484 net CCR true-up under-recovery for the period January 2012 through December 2012 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Order No. 25773, dated February 24, 1992. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibits of FPL witness Terry J. Keith.
- 4. By Order No. PSC-12-0664-FOF-EI, the Commission approved CCR Factors for the period commencing January 2, 2013. These factors reflected an actual/estimated true-up under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2012 through December 2012 of \$15,878,460, which was also approved in Order No. PSC-12-0664-FOF-EI. The actual under-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2012 through December 2012 is \$23,791,944. The \$23,791,944 actual under-recovery, less the actual/estimated under-recovery of \$15,878,460, results in a net CCR true-up under-recovery of \$7,913,484 that is to be included in the calculation of the CCR Factors for the period beginning January 2014.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve for the period ending December 2012: (1) FPL's net FCR true-up amount of \$4,550,654 under-recovery and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the FCR Factors for the period beginning January 2014 and (2) FPL's net CCR true-up amount of \$7,913,484 under-recovery and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the CCR Factors for the period beginning January 2014.
