In particular, with respect to CR3, my responsibilities included leading the Company's evaluation of whether to repair or retire CR3.

In this Request for Confidential Classification, PEF is seeking confidential classification for portions of PEF's responses to Citizens' Seventh Request for Production (Nos. 63-66), specifically number 66 in Docket 100437-EI. Portions of the documents responsive to Request No. 65 contain proprietary confidential business information related to projected and estimated insurance numbers, the disclosure of which would adversely impact PEF's competitive business interests by disclosing its sensitive business information. 

8. This concludes my affidavit.

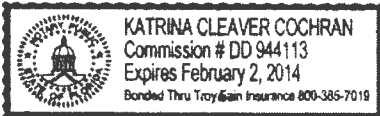
