REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain information produced in connection with Commission Staff's review of Gulf Power's 2012 expenditures in the above-referenced docket (ACN 13-015-1-1) (the "Review"). As grounds for this request, the Company states:

1. A portion of the information contained in Commission Staff's workpapers which were developed in connection with the Review constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" as defined by section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes (the "Confidential Information").
2. Specifically, the Confidential Information consists of pricing data for chemicals and stone products purchased by Gulf for use in its day-to-day operations. Disclosure of this information would impair Gulf Power's ability to continue to procure such goods at prices favorable to its customers insofar as vendors of such goods would be given insight into prices paid by Gulf and could adjust their pricing accordingly. The information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes.
3. The information filed pursuant to this Request is intended to be, and is treated as, confidential by Gulf Power and, to this attorney's knowledge, has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.
4. Submitted as Exhibit "A" are copies of the subject documents. The information for which confidential classification is requested is highlighted in yellow. Exhibit "A" should be




