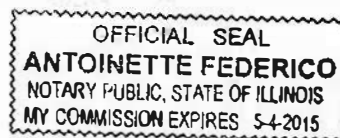

Commission Staff will have sign-up sheets, and customers will be called in the order that they sign up to speak.
