On July 17, 2013, the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (CHPK) filed its request for confidential classification for Document No. 04109-13. This document is a cost of service study that is part of a special gas transportation agreement between CHPK and JDC Development, LLC (JDC). The information in the document for which CHPK seeks confidential treatment relates to the charges at which CHPK will provide gas service to JDC. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with CHPK that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm CHPK's competitive business operations.

Therefore, staff recommends that CHPK's request for confidential classification of Document No. 04109-13 be approved.
