On August 28, 2013, Sunlake Estates Utilities, L.L.C. (Sunlake or Utility) filed its request for confidential classification for Document No. 05047-13. The document is part of Sunlake's response to a staff deficiency letter, dated July 26, 2013. Certain information produced in response to staff's deficiency letter consists of financial information related to Sunlake's privately-held parent companies, ALL TRS Holding Company and Asset Investors Operating Partnership, L.P. The Utility claims the information is intended to be, and is treated by Sunlake and its parent companies as private and confidential, has not been disclosed externally, and has been strictly controlled internally. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with the Utility that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business interests, operations, and private negotiations of Sunlake's parent companies. Therefore, staff recommends that Sunlake's request for confidential classification of Document No. 05047-13 be approved.
