Dear Mr. Eastep:

During a recent review of Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) records, staff became aware that your company did not file monthly Florida Telecommunications Relay, Inc. (FTRI) reports during 2012, indicating the number of telecommunications access lines in service. However, our records indicate that you did pay Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAF) during 2012.

All Florida local telecommunications companies are required to impose a monthly surcharge on all local exchange telecommunications company subscribers to fund Florida's Relay Service. The current surcharge is \$0.11 per month on the first 25 access lines per account bill rendered.

Because your company did not report any telecommunications access lines to FTRI, there is a noticeable discrepancy between FTRI records and FPSC records. Through this letter, staff is requesting that you provide an explanation regarding the discrepancy. Please forward your response by September 27, 2013.
