Thank you for your call today. The notice for Exhibit M to the application was filed under letter dated August 29 to Ann Cole. The notice for Exhibit N is the same. I have attached a copy of this for your ready reference.

Addressing your second question, please disregard the reference under Part VI of the application of \$1,750 for the filing fee. The appropriate filing fee is that filing fee which was filed -- \$1,000. This application is to extend Forest's territory to provide service to a single large customer – the Jamaica Bay Manufactured Home Community. The Community is built out and has been built out since the execution of the Bulk Service Agreement in 2005 (which is on file with the Commission). The rule provides that the appropriate filing fee for applications in which the area to be extended has a capacity to serve from 501 to 2,000 ERCs is \$1,000. The Community is comprised of 1,417 manufactured homes, well within the 2,000 ERCs as referenced within the rule (excerpt from Bulk Service Agreement attached).

BULK SERVICE AGREEMENT

THIS BULK SERVICE AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of the 21 day of <u>Septer</u>, 2005, between Forest Utilities, Inc., a Florida corporation (hereinafter the "Utility"), and Jamaica Bay West Association, Limited Partnership, a Florida limited partnership (hereinafter the "Developer")

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Developer has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Developer and the residents of the Jamaica Bay Community to obtain bulk wastewater treatment services from the Utility; and

WHEREAS, the Utility is willing to provide bulk wastewater service under the terms and conditions outlined in this Bulk Service Agreement (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, for the time being, Developer will continue to operate and maintain the onsite sewage treatment collection facilities and to continue to own the wastewater treatment facility located within the Jamaica Bay Community; and

WHEREAS, upon interconnection of the Developer's sewage collection system located within the Jamaica Bay Community with the collection system of the Utility, Developer will begin receiving bulk wastewater service from the Utility and will retire Developer's existing wastewater treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, Developer will contribute the sum of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$100,000) toward the interconnection of its collection system with the collection system of the Utility, at a location to be specified by the Utility; and

WHEREAS, Developer will pay to the Utility the sum of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$350,000) toward service availability and connection fees due under the Utility's approved tariff; and

WHEREAS, Developer will reimburse the Utility for professional service costs incurred to date and will reimburse the Utility for any future costs incurred in effectuating this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Utility will acquire the necessary easements located outside of Developer's property to effectuate the interconnections and the provisions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Utility will file a request with the Florida Public Service Commission for approval of a bulk service rute in the amount of \$3.14 per thousand, which rate shall be based upon metered water usage and such rates shall be charged to Developer on a monthly basis for sewage services provided;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants and conditions outlined herein which shall be deemed an integral part of this Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, the Developer and the Utility, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:

 <u>Definitions</u>. The following definitions and references are given for the purpose of interpreting terms as used in this Bulk Service Agreement.

 (a) "Agreement" - This Bulk Service Agreement for the provision of bulk sanitary sewer service to the Jamaica Bay Community.

(b) "Contributions-in-aid-of-construction (CIAC)" - The Developer will pay to the Utility the sum of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND and 00/100 (\$100,000) as contribution towards construction costs as a condition of the Utility's agreement to provide utility service to the Jamaica Bay Community. Such term does not refer to charges agreed to herein for reimbursement for professional or consulting fees or similar charges.

(c) "The property" or the "Jamaica Bay Community" - The Jamaica Bay Manufactured Home Community located at 15235 S. Tamiami Trail, Fort Myers, Lee County, Florida 33908, comprised of approximately 1,417 manufactured homes, as more fully described in Exhibit "1" attached hereto.

(d) "Developer" and "Utility" - These terms are used to identify Jamaica Bay West Associates, Limited Partnership, and Forest Utilities, Inc., respectively and are intended by both parties to include the successors and assigns of the parties as well as any subsequent owners of the Utility or the wastewater facilities located within the Jamaica Bay Community. Both parties intend that those successors, assigns and later owners are to be notified of the terms of this Agreement and to be bound by the terms of this Agreement to the extent this Agreement affects those parties.

(e) "Onsite System" or "Jamaica Bay facility"- All sewer or wastewater utility transmission and collection facilities located within the Jamaica Bay Community and all of those such facilities located outside the Jamaica Bay Community which are currently in existence or to be constructed in the future, in order to interconnect the sewage system within the Jamaica Bay Community to the facilities owned by the Utility that are within its existing sewer service territory.

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
