Re: Publicly Published Price Schedules

Dear Hayes E-Government Resources, Inc.:

As a result of the 2011 Florida Legislature amending Section 364.04, Florida Statutes, related to price schedules, incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies are no longer required to file price schedules with the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) for services other than network access services, but are required to publically publish this information in a readily accessible media, including a web site. Competitive local exchange companies are also required to publicly publish price schedules and may, but are not required to, file these schedules with the Commission.

The Commission revised its rules relating to the filing of price schedules and added the option of filing this information electronically through the E-Tariff system. In addition, Commission Rule 25-4.0341(2), F.A.C., requires that "[e]ach local telecommunications company that elects not to file service schedules with the Commission shall notify the Office of Telecommunications ... of the location where such service schedules are available to its customers." For these reasons we are requesting the following information:

1. Does your company currently publicly publish your price schedules for services offered in Florida at a location other than the Florida Public Service Commission?
2. If the answer to the question above is yes, please indicate where the schedule(s) is published. If published on a web site or sites, please include the complete address with the date the page was last updated.
3. If your company maintains price schedules with the Commission, does it submit the filing electronically or by mail?
4. If your company currently files by mail, has the company considered filing electronically?
5. What expense, if any, would be imposed on your company if it were required to file electronically?
