Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light requests an extension of confidential classification of highlighted information in the Company's Form 423 filings for October and November, 2011. By Order No. PSC-12-0113-CFO-EI, issued March 12, 2012, confidentiality was granted for an 18 month period. This extension request was filed on August 21, 2013, and seeks to extend that confidentiality for an additional 18 month period.

Staff has reviewed Florida Power & Light's confidentiality request, and in staff's opinion, this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for the extension of confidentiality of certain information included in Document Nos. 00276-12 (the October, 2011 filing) and 00439-12 (the November, 2011 filing) be approved.
