On November 13, 2013, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) and Peace River Electric Cooperative, Inc. (PRECO) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 06928-13. This document contains an identification of customers who will be transferred as a result of the petition. The information for which FPL and PRECO seek confidential treatment relates to specific account information for the identified individual customers. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPL and PRECO that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm utility customers' competitive business operations.

Therefore, staff recommends that FPL and PRECO's request for confidential classification of Document No. 06928-13 be approved.
