**NOTICE OF RE-SET HEARING ON TRUSTEE'S MOTION FOR ORDER
APPROVING COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT BETWEEN THE CHAPTER 7
TRUSTEE AND RONALD HUTCHISON UNDER FEDERAL RULE OF BANKRUPTCY
PROCEDURE 9019**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Jeffrey K. Kerr, the Chapter 7 trustee (the "Trustee") in the above styled case, filed a motion and related papers [Doc. No. 29; the "Settlement Motion"] with the Court seeking an order authorizing the settlement of a dispute with Ronald Hutchison. The complete terms of the proposed settlement, **including the Trustee's proposed release of Network Enhanced Telecom, LLP**, are set forth in the Settlement Agreement between the Trustee and Ronald Hutchison, attached as Exhibit "A" to the Settlement Motion.

An Objection [Doc. No. 34] to the relief sought in the Settlement Motion was timely filed by John M. Wise. No other Objections were filed. After the initial hearing, the Objection was scheduled for an evidentiary hearing on October 16, 2013. Prior to the hearing, the Trustee, John M. Wise and Ronald Hutchison entered into a Joint Stipulation [Doc. No. 38]. As a result of the filing of the Joint Stipulation, the hearing was cancelled.

John M. Wise has not identified competent counsel, satisfactory to the Trustee, to pursue the claim against Network Enhanced Telecom, LLP. Consistent with the terms of the Joint Stipulation, this Notice is filed to re-set the Settlement Motion for hearing.
