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UTILITIES INC.'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

UTILITIES, INC. ("Utility" or "UI") by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 (6), Florida Administrative Code, files this Motion for Protective Order with regard to a document responsive to Staff's Second Interrogatories (No. 5 a).

1. Pursuant to Section 367.156(2), Florida Statutes, this Commission has the authority to classify certain material as proprietary confidential business information. This classification exempts the material from public disclosure under Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes.

2. The Utility requests that all of the information provided in response to Staff's Interrogatory 5 a from which an annual salary can be determined be classified as proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 367.156(2), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code. The disclosure of salary information has been determined to be proprietary confidential business information. Florida Power & Light Company v. Public Service Commission, 31 So 3d 860 (Fla. 1<sup>st</sup> DCA 2010).

3. This Commission has recognized the confidentiality of salary information on numerous occasions. See, for example, recent Order Nos. PSC-14-0125-CFO-WS and PSC-14-0060-CFO-WS.

WHEREFORE, UTILITIES, INC. requests the entry of a protective order protecting against public disclosure of confidential information as set forth in the request as set forth above.
