To whom it may concern:

In the Florida Public Service Commission order of August 2012, the cost of refurbishing the surge tank, as recommended by the DEP, was projected to be \$9,639. A Phase II rate increase was approved pending the completion of this repair and documentation of the costs involved.

Since that time, the DEP has deemed the surge tank beyond repair. As a temporary measure, we have taken surge tank #1 off line, and have shifted processing to surge tank #2 west. It is adequate for our current needs. We are still in discussion with engineers and the DEP about a long term goal of shift processing to Surge Tank #2 east.

Rather than implementing the Phase II rate increase which was based on a different set of figures, we would like to forgo the increase now, with the understanding that we will come back to the Commission for authorization to recover the full cost of this re-design of the plant.
