AFFIDAVIT OF MARK MASON

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Mark Mason who, being first duly sworn deposes and says:

1. My name is Mark Mason. I am currently employed by FPL as General Manager Field Service Operations. My business address is 9250 West Flagler Street, Miami, Florida 33174. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed the documents that are included in FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of Information of Certain Documents Produced in Response to Public Counsel's First Request For Production (Docket No. 130223-EI), for which I am listed as the affiant. Such documents or materials that I have reviewed and which, in whole or in part, are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information, contain or constitute competitively sensitive information, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Specifically, the material consists of employee compensation or benefits information. Public disclosure of compensation or benefits would enable competing employers to meet or beat the compensation offered by FPL, resulting in the loss of talented employees, or conversely, the need to increase the level of compensation already paid in order to retain these employees and attract new talent. Furthermore, disclosure of the compensation or benefits information of the type included in Exhibit A gives rise to concerns about infighting or morale among employees. Again, this could lead to higher wages, which ultimately result in higher rates for FPL's customers. In addition, some of the documents contain customer-specific account information. It is FPL's corporate policy not to disclose customer-specific information. This policy includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh usage), conservation savings in kW, kWh and bills. FPL treats such information as confidential and does not disclose it, except as required by law, to entities or persons other than the customer absent the customer's consent. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials.

3. Consistent with the provisions of the Florida Administrative Code, such materials should remain confidential for a period of not less than 18 months. In addition, they should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business so that FPL can continue to maintain the confidentiality of these documents.

4. Affiant says nothing further.
