RE: Docket No. 140078-TP - Request for approval of amendment to CMRS agreement between Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink and Sprint PCS.

By letter received April 10, 2014, Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink filed a request for approval of the amendment to the CMRS agreement with the Sprint PCS entities authorized to conduct business in Florida – Sprint Spectrum L.P. and SprintCom, Inc. d/b/a Sprint PCS. APC PSC, L.L.C., Phillieco, L.P., Sprint Telephony PSC, L.P. f/k/a Cox Communications PSC, L.P., and Wirelesco, L.P. are not currently authorized to conduct business in Florida. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on June 30, 2014. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d. of the Administrative Procedures Manual. Therefore, it has gone into effect by operation of law in accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
