UTILITIES INC. OF PENNBROOKE - CUSTOMER NOTICE

Dated July 21, 2014

Section 367.0816, Florida Statutes, requires that rate case expense be recovered over a period of four years. The statute further requires that the rates of the utility be reduced immediately at the conclusion of the four years by the amount of rate case expense previously included in the rates.

Utilities, Inc. of Pennbrooke was granted a rate increase by the Florida Public Service Commission in Order No. PSC-10-0400-PAA-WS, issued on 06/18/2010 in Docket No. 090392-WS. The four-year recovery period for rate case expense will expire on 07/30/2014. Effective 07/31/2014 the rates will be reduced as follows:
