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PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Good morning
afternoon. It's been a long day for me. This is the
FPUC rate case prehearing in Docket Number 140025-EI.
It is 3:00 p.m. on September 4th, 2014. Staff, can you
please read the notice.

MS. BROWNLESS: Yes, ma'am. The purpose of this Prehearing Conference is to simplify the issues, identify the positions of the parties on the issues, consider the possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and documents which will avoid unnecessary proof, identify exhibits, establish an order of witnesses, and consider such other matters as may aid in the disposition of the action.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. And I'd like to take appearances, starting with my left.

MS. KEATING: Good afternoon, Commissioner.

Beth Keating with the Gunster Law Firm. I'm here this afternoon on behalf of Florida Public Utilities.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.

MS. CHRISTENSEN: Good afternoon. Patty

Christensen with the Office of Public Counsel. And I'd

like to put in an appearance on behalf of J. R. Kelly,

Public Counsel, and Erik Sayler, who is Associate Public

Counsel. Thank you.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. 1 Commission staff. 2 MS. BROWNLESS: Yes, ma'am. Suzanne Brownless 3 on behalf of Commission staff, and I'm also entering a 4 notice of appearance for Martha Barrera. 5 6 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. 7 MS. HELTON: And Mary Anne Helton, and I'm here as your advisor. 8 9 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** A great advisor. 10 you. Staff, are there any preliminary matters we 11 12 need to address at this time? 13 MS. BROWNLESS: Yes, ma'am. The parties have 14 filed a joint motion for approval of a stipulation and 15 settlement agreement on August 29th. The staff is in the process of reviewing the agreement at this time. 16 17 The staff does not anticipate filing a written recommendation but will be providing an oral 18 recommendation at the time of the Commission vote. 19 We have produced a draft Comprehensive Exhibit 20 21 List, which includes all service hearing exhibits, all 22 MFRs, prefiled testimony, and prefiled exhibits for 23 parties and staff. This exhibit list is consistent with 24 paragraph 16 of the settlement agreement.

Staff will distribute the list to the parties

for their review and ask them -- and will ask that this

list be moved into evidence at the beginning of the

September 15th hearing should the settlement agreement

be approved by the Commission. Please, for the parties,

if you can review our draft exhibit list and get back

with us with any changes, we would appreciate it.

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There's one additional item. The Office of Public Counsel had indicated that they didn't believe the confidentiality request for portions of Donna Ramos's testimony had been ruled upon, and they were particularly concerned about document number 04030-14. I would advise them that there were several versions of Ms. Ramos's testimony of which there were confidential portions, and all were addressed in Order Number PSC-14-0438 issued on August 20th. And so, therefore, there are no outstanding confidentiality matters at this time.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.

Ms. Christensen, any comment?

MS. CHRISTENSEN: In the abundance of caution, we, as part of our review of the prehearing order, we just raised that with staff. And we appreciate that they advised us that it had been taken care of and that the ruling on confidentiality had been taken care of.

We just didn't want that as an outstanding matter before

the hearing.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. And that's taken care of. And at this point we're going to discuss the consideration of the settlement agreement. I want to thank the parties for presenting the Commission with a settlement agreement. I've looked at it very briefly at this point, but we appreciate that for our consideration.

So the settlement agreement that was filed on August 29th is going to be considered as a matter of first business at the -- on the first day of the hearing scheduled for Monday, September 15th. In light of the fact that the -- and that's correct, Ms. Brownless?

MS. BROWNLESS: Yes, ma'am.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. In light of the fact that the -- in light of that fact, this Prehearing Conference will be continued until Wednesday [sic],

September -- and I think I said Monday, September 15th, but it's actually Tuesday, September 15th [sic]. My apologies. This Prehearing Conference though, in light of the fact that the settlement agreement was filed, will be continued until Wednesday [sic], September 16th, should the panel vote not to approve the settlement agreement. And if the settlement agreement is approved on September 15th, there will be no need to hold a

Prehearing Conference obviously, as all issues in the case will be, have been resolved.

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The parties, my understanding is that the parties have previously and formally agreed to abate discovery; is that correct?

MS. KEATING: That's correct.

MS. CHRISTENSEN: Yes, that's correct.

commissioner brown: Okay. So depositions, responses to ROGs and PODs have agreed, have been agreed to be abated. And that's great in order to save on rate case expense. It's much appreciated. And all discovery will, in fact, continue to be abated until there is a vote on the settlement agreement on the 15th.

Should it be necessary to conduct the prehearing on September 16th, new discovery parameters and deadlines will be set at that time. And all outstanding disputes regarding issues, exhibits, testimony will also be addressed, as well as dates for the actual formal administrative hearing. Are there any questions by the parties?

MS. KEATING: None from FPUC. We just, we appreciate the Commission staff working with us, and we're very happy to bring forward this settlement that we think is a fair and reasonable resolution of this case, and we appreciate it.

10	MS. BROWNLESS: No, ma'am.
11	COMMISSIONER BROWN: This is the quickest
12	Prehearing Conference and we are now adjourned. Thank
13	you very much. Have a good afternoon.
