On October 7, 2014, you were notified of eight deficiencies in your application for the above-described certificate transfer. At that time, you were also asked to provide additional information regarding the street lighting charge imposed by the Utility. The deadline to provide this information was November 5, 2014.

On November 10, 2014, you provided a written response with regard to Deficiency No. 2. No other responses for Deficiencies No. 1, the filing fee of \$1,500, or Deficiencies Nos. 3-8 were provided nor did you provide any information with regard to the street lighting charge.

Sections 367.121(1) and 350.117(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.110(2), F.A.C., require that you respond to all Commission data requests. Please pay the filing fee and provide the information necessary to complete your application by January 22, 2015. Failure to pay the filing fee and provide the information necessary to correct these deficiencies will result in our recommendation to deny your application for approval of the transfer of Certificate No. 117-W. Please be further advised that should your application for transfer of Certificate No. 117-W be denied, we will evaluate whether Docket No. 140175-WU, the staff assisted rate case for Crestridge Utilities, LLC, should be closed. No refund of the filing fee would be made if Docket No. 140175-WU is ultimately closed.

The above-referenced application has been received and reviewed by Commission staff. Please complete the following deficiencies and provide the requested additional information to clarify the application.

Deficiencies

- 1) Application Fee. Rule 25-30.020(2)(c), F.A.C., requires that an application fee be paid for an application for authority to transfer filed pursuant to Section 367.071, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Staff has determined that an application fee of \$1,500 is due for this application. Please remit your payment to the Commission's Division of Administrative and IT Services, referencing the docket number. A failure to pay the application fee may result in this docket being closed.
- 2) Utilities Owned by Buyer. Rule 25-30.037(2)(f), F.A.C., requires the application list the names and locations of any other water or wastewater utilities owned by the buyer. Although the Utility indicated that it owns other water or wastewater utilities, staff notes that these utilities may not be owned by the Buyer, Crestridge Utilities, LLC. Please provide information regarding the relationship between the two companies listed and the buyer.
- 3) Purchase Price. Rule 25-30.037(2)(g)(1), F.A.C., requires that the contract for sale include the purchase price and terms of payment. While the contract specifies the combined purchase price and terms of payment for Crestridge Utility Corporation and Holiday Gardens Utilities, Inc., it does not indicate how the purchase price is allocated or assigned to each utility. Please provide the dollar amount paid for each water system separately.
- 4) Assets and Liabilities. Rule 25-30.037(2)(g)(2), F.A.C., requires a list of and the dollar amount of the assets purchased and liabilities assumed or not assumed, including those of nonregulated operations or entities. Please provide a list of the specific assets and liabilities including the dollar amounts allocated to each.

- 5) Public Interest. Rule 25-30.037(2)(j), F.A.C., requires a "statement indicating how the transfer is in the public interest, including a summary of the buyer's experience in water or wastewater utility operations, a showing of the buyer's financial ability to provide service, and a statement that the buyer will fulfill the commitments, obligations and representations of the seller with regard to utility matters." Exhibit 1 to the Application contains a statement regarding the buyer's experience in the water and wastewater utility industry. However, Exhibit 1 does not contain a showing of the buyer's financial ability to provide service. Please provide a showing of the buyer's financial ability to provide service, such as a recent personal financial statement showing the buyer's assets and liabilities.
- 6) Financial Statements. Rule 25-30.037(2)(k), F.A.C., requires a list of all entities upon which the applicant is relying to provide funding to the buyer, and an explanation of the manner and amount of such funding, which shall include their financial statements and copies of any financial agreements with the Utility. In its Application, the Utility provided the statement "N/A." Please provide current financial statements of any person or entity with an ownership interest greater than 10 percent.
- 7) Tariffs. Rule 25-30.037(2)(s), F.A.C., requires the original and two copies of sample tariff sheets reflecting the change in ownership. The sample tariff sheets provided in the application are insufficient as this time. The utility will need to update all pages in its water tariffs to reflect the change in ownership if the transfer application is approved. Please provide an original and two copies of the utility's complete water and wastewater tariffs reflecting the change in ownership.

8) Notice of Application and Legal Description. Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C., require the utility to provide notice of its application for transfer. The legal description was not included in the application. Staff suggests that the utility use the following previously approved legal description.

 - b. Please provide a copy of the street lighting electric bills to the Utility from the electric provider for the most recent 12-month period;
 - c. Please explain why the Utility is charging its customers for street lighting.
 - d. Please provide invoices, by month, associated with the cost of providing street lighting for the utility customers for the most recent 12-month period.
