PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE:

The purpose of this hearing is to consider Brenda Rodriguez's complaint against Duke Energy Florida, Inc. for alleged improper billing and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on February 4, 2015. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

This Commission is vested with jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding by the provisions of Sections 366.03, 366.041, 366.05, 366.06, 366.07, Florida Statutes, and any other relevant sections of Chapter 366, Florida Statutes, applicable to this proceeding, in addition to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-6, 25-9, 25-22, and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
