On February 16, 2015, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc., (Peninsula) and the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (Chesapeake) filed a joint request for confidential classification for Document No. 01002-15. This document contains responses to staff's data request and accompanying Attachment 1. The information in the document for which Peninsula and Chesapeake seek confidential treatment relates to construction companies and costs, reservation charges, the maximum daily transportation quantity (MDTQ), and capital investments. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with Peninsula and Chesapeake that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would be harmful to the competitive business operations of Peninsula and Chesapeake.

Therefore, staff recommends that the joint request of Peninsula and Chesapeake for confidential classification of Document No. 01002-15 be approved.
