Regarding Document No. 04136-15, FPL's response to FIPUG's 3rd Request for Production of Document Requests, No. 14, staff finds that the confidentiality request should not be granted in full. Staff notes that the company has requested confidentiality for the whole of the document, and not provided a page-and-line justification. Given that similar information was not requested confidential in Document No. 04451-15, Exhibit 38, staff finds that the similar information is not confidential and should not be approved as confidential. However, consistent with Document No. 04451-15, some portions of Document No. 04136-15 staff would recommend to be confidential.
