Does anyone else have this company for a utility? Can you believe that they are asking to recoup the loss of \$186,000.00 dollars, when the HOA's go and cut water usage by 46% and install their own wells and irrigation systems, (saving Florida's natural resources: Water) with that cost coming out of the home owners pockets. That Utilities Inc and Corix has the gall to ask the Florida Public Service Commission the right to recover these losses, under Florida's Laws. Utilities Inc., latest rate increase request (docket 150269-WS) if approved by the FPSC, would have the residents here paying the following:

Base Facility Charge by meter size (5/8"-3/4") present rate \$11.19. UTILITY PROPOSED PHASE II Rate \$14.24/ month.

Charge per 1,000 gallons of Fresh Water (??) present rate \$5.17/per thousand UTILITY PROPOSED PHASE II Rate \$ 6.58.

We would also pay a RWS (resident water service) for Sewer which present rate is at \$12.57 And on top of that fee, We would also pay a rate of \$10.68/ per Thousand gallons of sewer, which as you can see is based on the fresh water usage.

Utilities Inc., DOES NOT EVEN PROCCESS or TREAT the sewer, but instead pipes it to the county to treat and they Pay a much more reduce rate.

(BFC and RWS is one in the same charge, just listed different on our bills.) Thank You.
