PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE OF INFINITE ENERGY, INC.

COMES NOW, Infinite Energy, Inc. ("Infinite Energy"), pursuant to Florida Public Service Commission Rule 25-22.039, F.A.C., and hereby files this Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above-captioned docket. In support of this Petition, Infinite Energy respectfully shows as follows.

1.

Infinite Energy is a wholesale and retail marketer of natural gas incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida with its principal place of business at 7001 SW 24th Avenue, Gainesville, Florida 32607.

2.

Infinite Energy is a recognized third party supplier ("Pool Manager") on the Peoples Gas System ("PGS") serving numerous Florida consumers electing to take transportation service under the PGS tariff.

3.

Infinite Energy has substantial interests which are subject to determination or will be affected through this proceeding. Which include, but are not limited to the following:

 As proposed, PGS' tariff modifications will greatly impact the rates currently paid by customers electing transportation service under the NaturalChoice Transportation Service ("NCTS") and Individual Transportation Service ("ITS") Riders, respectively. With regards to NCTS customers, PGS is proposing to change, "...the rate, or reservation charge, at which releases of upstream capacity to Pool Managers under Rider NCTS will be made.", in order to help recover the, "...costs of upstream pipeline capacity held by PGS for peaking and future growth....", and

2) With respect to ITS customers, PGS is proposing to modify the cash-out price for negative monthly imbalance amounts. PGS currently applies the usage rates of Rate Schedule FTS-1 (\$0.5518/MMBtu) pursuant to the Florida Gas Transmission Company ("FGT") tariff, in the methodology to determine the cash-out price. PGS is proposing to update that methodology by using instead the usage and maximum reservation rates of FGT's Rate Schedule FTS-3 (\$1.3299/MMBtu). This methodology will also apply to customers taking service under the NCTS Rider.

4.

Infinite Energy's rights and interests cannot be adequately represented by any other party in this docket and its participation in this matter will not unduly delay these proceedings or prejudice any other party.

5.

Infinite Energy respectfully requests that it be granted leave to intervene and participate fully as a party in this proceeding, including the right to present testimony and exhibits, cross-examine witnesses, and file briefs.
