Re: **160000-OT: [Undocketed] - Charter Communications, Inc.'s Acquisition of Indirect Ultimate Control of Time Warner Cable Business LLC and Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC**

Dear Ms. Stauffer:

On July 2, 2015, the undersigned informed the Commission of a transaction, whereby Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter") would acquire majority organizational control of both Time Warner Cable Inc., the parent of Time Warner Cable Business LLC ("TWCB"), holder of CLEC Certificate No. 8679, as well as Bright House Networks, LLC, the parent of Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC ("BHNIS"), holder of CLEC Certificate No. 8015.¹

Charter hereby notifies the Commission that, on May 18, 2016, the transactions detailed in the July 2, 2015 notices were consummated and Charter (reorganized into "New Charter" as set forth in the July 2, 2015 notice) is now the ultimate parent of both TWCB and BHNIS.²

Going forward, the designated regulatory and customer service contact for both TWCB and BHNIS regarding compliance with Florida laws and regulations will be:

¹ On August 5, 2015, the Commission (via its General Counsel) confirmed that Commission approval for the indirect transfers of control was not required, as they did not involve the transfer of the Florida CLEC certificates held by either TWCB or BHNIS.

² A chart reflecting the corporate organization of the post-transaction company in Florida is attached to this letter as Appendix A. Appendix A supersedes the chart originally attached as Exhibit A to the Commission forms accompanying the July 2 2015 notices to reflect the revised positioning of certain intermediary entities within Charter's corporate structure, but involves no material changes to either the control or the ultimate ownership of TWCB or BHNIS.



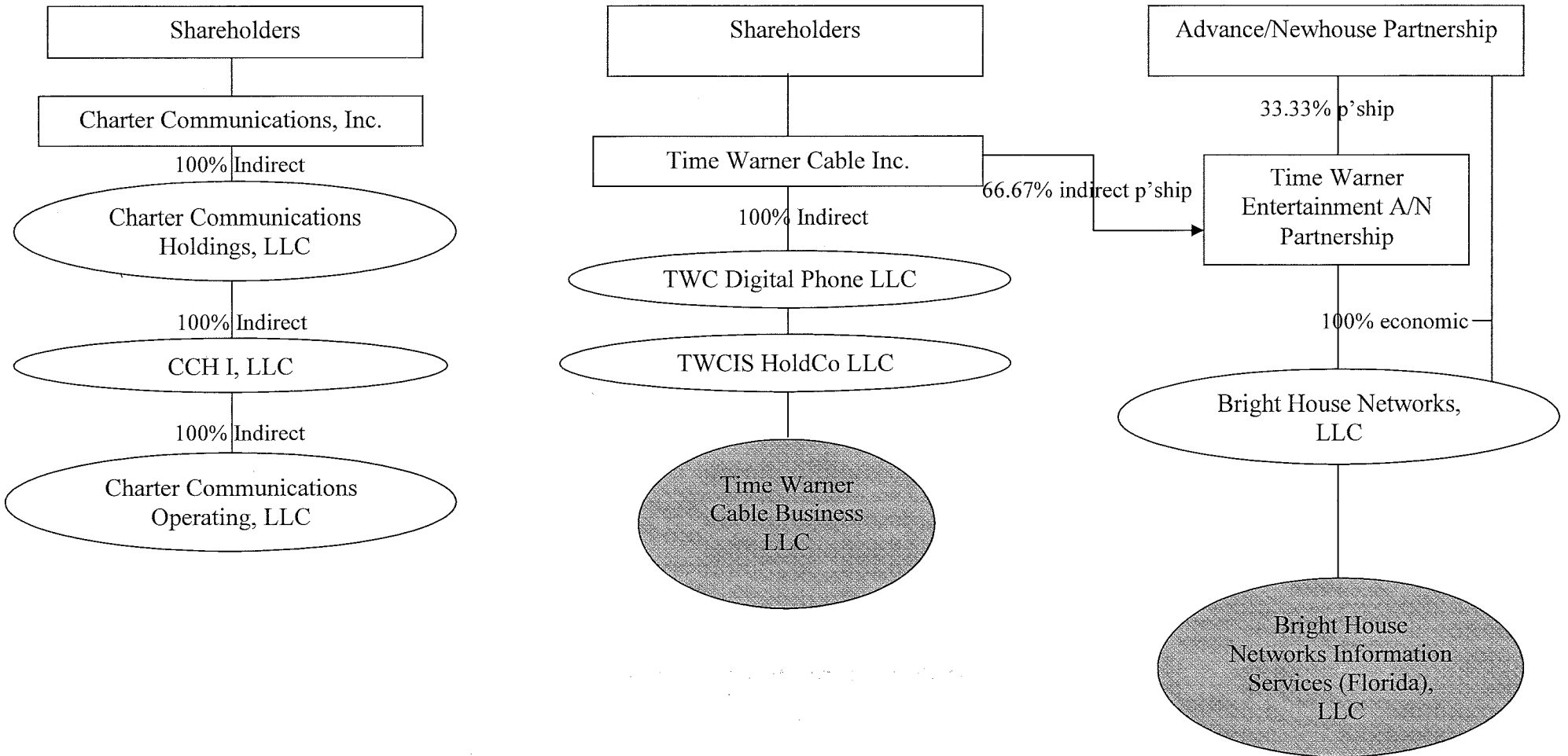

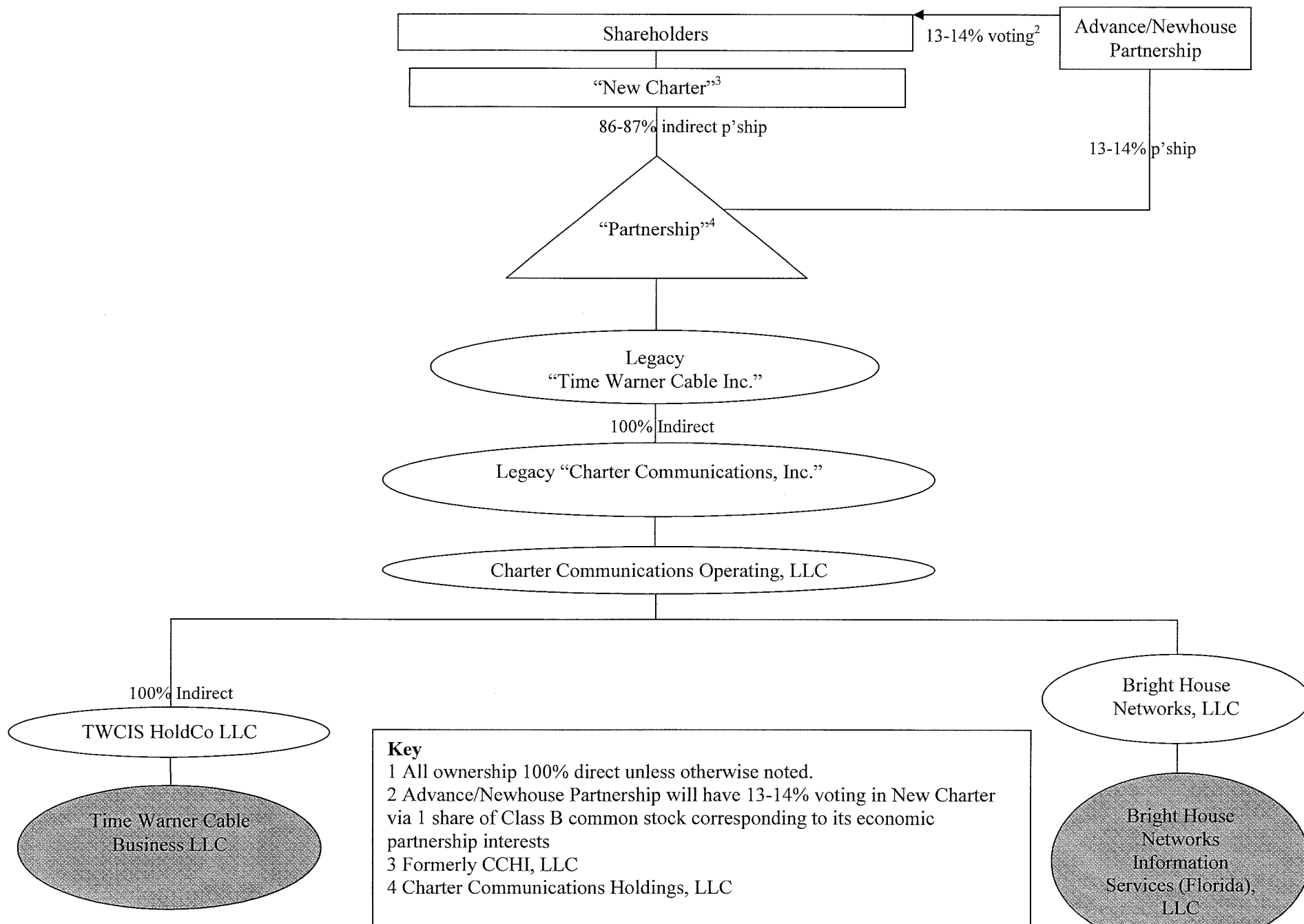
