# DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC'S MOTION REQUESTING WITHDRAWAL OF THE TARIFFS APPROVED IN DOCKET NUMBER 160128-EI

Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") hereby files this Motion Requesting Withdrawal of the Tariffs Approved in Docket Number 160128-EI.

- 1. Specifically, in Order No. PSC-16-0362-TRF-EI (Consummating Order PSC-16-0416-CO-EI), the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission") approved tariff sheets reflecting rate increases associated with phase 1 of the Hines Chillers Uprate Project ("Uprate Project") to be effective with the first billing cycle of November 2016. These tariff sheets were approved pursuant to the Revised and Restated Stipulation and Settlement Agreement ("RRSSA"), which authorized DEF to seek recovery of the prudently incurred revenue requirement of power uprates like the Uprate Project.
- 2. However, a portion of the common equipment that is required for all phases of the Uprate Project to be in-service will not be completed when previously expected. Therefore, DEF requests a withdrawal of the approved tariff sheets until DEF files another request with this

Commission to request approval of new tariff sheets to reflect the costs of both phases of the Uprate Project. In lieu of the approved tariff sheets, DEF will continue billing customers consistent with the tariff sheets that were on file with the FPSC before the effective date of the tariffs approved in Docket No. 160128.

WHEREFORE, DEF respectfully requests that this Commission allow DEF to withdraw the tariff sheets approved in Order No. PSC-16-0362-TRF-EI.
