2	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 4.
3	MR. LEE: Commissioners, Item 4 addresses Duke
4	Energy's petition regarding its proposed revenue
5	requirement and tariffs for the Osprey Plant
6	acquisition. The Osprey Plant acquisition was
7	approved by the Commission in 2015 in a need-
8	determination proceeding. Recovery of such costs
9	is allowed under the settlement agreement approved
10	by the Commission in 2013.
11	Staff's recommended revenue requirement is
12	based on the capital structure from the most-recent
13	earnings surveillance report and is approximately
14	\$140,000 lower than Duke Energy proposed.
15	In addition, Duke Energy filed a motion on
16	October 18 to request withdrawal of the tariffs
17	approved in Docket No. 160128-EI because a portion
18	of the common equipment required for the Hines
19	Chiller uprate project will not be completed as
20	previously expected.
21	The motion is addressed in Issue 3. And staff
22	recommends approval of Duke's motion. No customer
23	filed comments in this docket. Duke Energy
24	representative is present to answer questions. The
25	Office of Public Counsel has indicated that it does
