Hank,

After completing our internal analysis of the value of continuing to participate in SECO's load shedding program through the use of our emergency generators at three of our facilities, it has become apparent that we can no longer justify the costs associated with your interruptible tariff. Because SECO does not offer remote start functionality, my staff must be responsive on a frequent basis to manually start our generators at the beginning of each load shedding event, transfer the load to our generators, and then reverse the process when the event ends. The projected cost savings in our SECO bills is outweighed by the negative impact on our staff schedules. Additionally, the cost of fuel and maintenance to run the generators so frequently is significant. Therefore, please let this serve as notice that Lake Utility Services, Inc. formally requests cancellation of its participation in the SECO load shedding program effective immediately.

I appreciate you providing me with an analysis of the three applicable account histories in 2015. This was helpful in forming our decision.
