**Re: Docket No. 20170215-EU - Review of electric utility hurricane preparedness and restoration actions.**


To Whom It May Concern:

  - a. A description of the damage incurred (i.e. broken pole, displaced underground vault, etc.). Not applicable
  - b. A description of the repair process, including a description of any temporary repairs that required a follow-up trip. Not applicable
  - c. A description of the repair process if the facilities had not been hardened. Not applicable
