My name is Ruth Levant. I am a property owner on Don Pedro Island. My property is within the service area contained in the application from Environmental Utilities, LLC [EU] for central sewer.

I am writing specifically to object to EU's request for the bifurcation of the certificate and rate-making proceedings. I also object to the granting of a temporary waiver of Rules 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q).

Given the inadequate information regarding the applicant's financial strength and management experience as well as the costs to the stakeholders involved with this project, the applicant's request for a waiver should be denied. As a property owner in the proposed service area, it is necessary to have all of the relevant information regarding the proposed central sewer, including the proposed

rates, connection fees and the type of system intended for installation. Therefore, I formally request that EU's Motion to Bifurcate and a Temporary Waiver be denied.
