Dear PSC,

It is my understanding that when a utility company files their initial application for authorization to provide central sewer they **must** include the estimated connection fees, the anticipated monthly rates and details regarding the type of system to be installed. That said, I also understand that Environmental Utilities has filed a motion asking for a waiver to the Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q) requiring that this information be submitted at the time of the initial application.

This **rule exists for a reason**, and I find this **very disturbing** that Environmental Utilities feels they should not have to comply, and has therefore asked you to waive this requirement. **And I would find it even more disturbing if you granted their request.** Neither the PSC or people effected have asked Environmental Utilities to provide anything **more** than the Rule requires, so I do not feel the PSC should allow Environmental Utilities to provide anything **less** than the Rule requires. Doing so would be a disservice to the people you represent.
