My husband and I own four properties on Little Gasparilla Island, which is within the service area contained in the application from Environmental Utilities, LLC [EU] for central sewer. Given the inadequate information regarding the applicant's financial strength and management experience as well as the costs to the stakeholders involved with this project, the applicant's request for a temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q) should be denied. I also object to EU's request for the bifurcation of the certificate and rate-making proceedings.
