To Whom It May Concern,

I am the property owner of 8234 Little Gasparilla Island, Placida, FL, Charlotte County, which is within the service area contained in the application from Environmental Utilities, LLC [EU] for central sewer.

I object to EU's request for the bifurcation of the certificate and rate-making proceedings. Furthermore, I object to the granting of a temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q).

Appropriate information has not been provided to residents who will be effected by this substantial project that has critical environmental implications as well as the imposition of formidable expenses and inconveniences to island property owners.

Stakeholders in the proposed service area have NOT received the relevant information regarding the proposed central sewer, including: proposed rates, connection fees and the type of system intended for installation. There are also questions regarding the applicant's financial strength and management experience suggesting dubious credibility or qualifications for an undertaking of this magnitude.

I therefore request that EU's request for bifurcation and a temporary waiver be denied without further delay.
