I'd like to petition the commission to alter Rule 25-6.065, F.A.C in the following manner:

Adjust the upper limit of Tier 1 interconnection to 30kW instead of 10kW

Since the original rule was created some time ago, it does not account for the large growth in electric vehicles and other high-current-draw uses. It would benefit the residents of the state to be able to easily add sufficient solar to accommodate future use in a cost-effective manner.

Insurance premiums for Tier 2 may make adding more than 10kW cost prohibitive, and homeowners would not be able to enjoy the economies of scale available with larger rooftop solar systems.

I would think that increasing Tier 1 to 30kW with a manual disconnect would be a good compromise and help advance Florida in its goal to reduce carbon emissions.
