Duke Energy Florida, LLC (“DEF” or “the Company”), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby moves the Commission to abate the remaining scheduled items in this docket, and in support of this Motion states:

1. On January 14, 2021, a 2021 Settlement Agreement (“Settlement”) was filed in this docket and docket number 202100016-EI. DEF, Office of Public Counsel (“OPC” or “Citizens”), the Florida Industrial Power Users Group (“FIPUG”), PCS Phosphate d/b/a White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc. (“White Springs”), and Nucor Steel Florida, Inc. (“Nucor”), collectively referred to herein as “the Parties,” have resolved all issues and therefore, pending the Commission action on the Settlement, the remaining scheduled items are no longer necessary.
